Dear Employee of Mather Place,

We received notice last evening that an employee of Mather Place in Wilmette has a **confirmed positive case** of the Coronavirus disease (COVID-19). The employee is resting at home and is in quarantine for 14 days. We wish the employee a speedy recovery.

Mather Place is interviewing this individual to determine if he/she was in close contact with residents and/or employees (meaning within 6 feet of anyone for more than 10 minutes).

Mather Place continues to implement strong infection control and sanitation protocols to minimize the spread of the virus.

- All employees and caregivers are being health-screened twice per 8-hour shift, including a temperature check.
- Anyone entering the community is required to wear a mask.
- High-touch areas within the community are cleaned and disinfected every 2-4 hours during daytime.
- Practicing good hand-washing techniques; using sanitizer when hand washing is not possible.
- Practicing physical distancing (at least six feet from another person and for less than 10 minutes)
- Delivering meals and packages to residents by putting them on a chair outside residents' apartments
- Wearing Personal Protective Equipment (PPE), including a gown/coat (disposable), gloves, and face shield or goggles if needed, to enter a resident's apartment home
