

COVID-19 UPDATE

March 30, 2021

Dear Residents and Family Members,

We received notice yesterday, March 29, 2021, that a **resident of Mather Place in Wilmette has a confirmed positive case of COVID-19**. We wish them a full recovery. Mather Place is interviewing this individual to determine if he/she was in close contact with residents and/or employees (meaning within 6 feet of anyone for more than 15 minutes). Individuals who have been in close contact will be notified.

COMMUNITY UPDATES

- Residents can visit with each other in their apartment homes. Please limit visits to three neighbors at time.
- Get Fit is now open Monday through Friday, and three people can use it at once. Reservations are required. To reserve, please call the Concierge at (847) 256.9300.
- The pool is open daily from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., with a limit of four people in the pool. Appointments are no longer needed. Pool fitness classes will start up sometime in April.
- In-person programming in Possibilities I is available for up to ten people.
- Games are back, with mah-jongg in the Gateway Gallery, and poker in the Gazebo. Games are all first-come, first-serve. Masks are required at all times, and we ask that you wash your hands before and after the games.
- Visitors are welcome and can be hosted inside apartment homes with safety measures in place.

PLEASE PROTECT YOURSELF & OTHERS

For the opportunities listed above, and for all times when residents are outside of their apartment homes or entertaining guests inside their apartment homes, we ask that everyone continue to practice infection-control protocols, including

- practicing physical distancing (no closer than 6 feet away for no more than 15 minutes)
- good hand hygiene by washing your hands frequently for 20 or more seconds
- wearing masks that cover your mouth and nose
