We received notice yesterday that **an employee of Mather Place in Wilmette has a confirmed positive case of COVID-19**. We wish them a full recovery.

Mather Place is interviewing this individual to determine if he/she was in close contact with residents and/or employees (meaning within 6 feet of anyone for more than 15 minutes). Individuals who have been in close contact will be notified.

IF YOU THINK YOU HAVE COVID-19:

With COVID-19 cases surging in our area, it's important to monitor yourself for symptoms of COVID-19, which include a loss of taste or smell, cough, fever, chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, shortness of breath, pink eye, eye pain, vertigo, and gastrointestinal issues such as diarrhea, nausea, or vomiting.

Please contact your physician, and let your HR representative know.**
