We wanted to inform you that we received notice today that **a resident of Mather Place in Wilmette has a confirmed positive case of COVID-19**. We wish them a full recovery.

Mather Place is interviewing this individual to determine if he/she was in close contact with residents and/or employees (meaning within 6 feet of anyone for more than 15 minutes). Individuals who have been in close contact will be notified.

MEALS AVAILABLE TO-GO ONLY:

Beginning tomorrow, we will move all meal service to carryout only. In order to reduce the risks of spreading COVID-19, our restaurants will be closed Friday, January 14 through Friday, January 21. Residents are welcome to order breakfast, lunch, and dinner to-go during these days, using our regular process. Residents who are not feeling well can request delivery at no charge.
