

COVID-19 UPDATE

Dear Residents and Family Members,

We wanted to inform you that we have learned that **a resident has tested positive for COVID-19**. We wish this individual a speedy recovery.

Mather Place is interviewing the individual to determine if they were in close contact with residents and/or employees (meaning within 6 feet of anyone for more than 15 minutes). Individuals who have been in close contact will be notified.

STEPS YOU CAN TAKE:

As we continue to live with COVID-19, we know how to reduce risk of infection:

1. Get your second booster shot.
2. Stay home when you feel ill.
3. Wear a mask when indoors in public space.
4. If you think you have COVID-19 or were exposed to COVID-19, get tested.

With Mother's Day coming up, consider taking steps to keep family gatherings safe. You can ask everyone planning to attend to take a home-based COVID-19 test 24 hours in advance. If anyone had recently been sick—even with a negative test result—please reconsider your plans. And if weather permits, consider moving your gathering outdoors.

Please take care and stay well.
