Dear Residents and Family Members,

We wanted to inform you that we have learned that **a resident of Mather Place has tested positive for COVID-19**. We wish this individual a speedy recovery.

Mather Place is interviewing the individual to determine if they were in close contact with residents and/or employees (meaning within 6 feet of anyone for more than 15 minutes). Individuals who have been in close contact will be notified.

PLEASE STAY HOME IF FEELING ILL:

Not only is the rate of COVID-19 increasing, but more people are also experiencing the common cold, flu, and allergies. **If you are experiencing any symptoms, we strongly encourage you to stay home and avoid spreading any illness you may have to others. If you think you have COVID-19 or were exposed to COVID-19, get tested.**

ADDITIONAL STEPS YOU CAN TAKE:

As cases continue to increase in our area, we encourage you to protect yourself by:

- Practicing good **hand hygiene** by washing your hands frequently for 20+ seconds.
- **Wearing a mask** that covers your mouth and nose when outside your apartment home.
