

COVID-19 UPDATE

Dear Residents and Family Members,

We wanted to inform you that we have learned that **four residents have tested positive for COVID-19**. We wish these individuals a speedy recovery.

Mather Place is interviewing the individuals to determine if they were in close contact with residents and/or employees (meaning within 6 feet of anyone for more than 15 minutes). Individuals who have been in close contact will be notified.

IN-PERSON DINING PAUSED:

We will continue to pause our in-person restaurant service. We will re-evaluate Friday and share an update. Residents have the option to pick-up their meal to-go or choose to have delivery for a fee.

HELP US REDUCE RISKS AND PROTECT YOURSELF:

- Regularly **use good hand hygiene** by washing your hands frequently for 20 seconds or more.
- Wear a face mask that covers your nose and mouth. K9N95 and surgical masks are available free of charge.
- Stay home when you feel ill, even with mild, cold-like symptoms. If you think you have COVID-19 or were exposed to COVID-19, get tested.
